

ANTHONY TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS

Regular Meeting

Wednesday November 7, 2018

The meeting was called to order by Richard R. Hess, Chair, at 7:00 P.M. In attendance were Supervisors Richard R. Hess, Dennis Sheatler and William Hartman. Solicitor Robert Buehner, Jr., Roadmaster Frank Rishel and 19 visitors were also in attendance.

All motions are approved unanimously unless otherwise noted.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 3, 2018 monthly meeting. Second Dennis Sheatler.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report for October. Second William Hartman.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve payment of the bills for November. Second Dennis Sheatler.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the work session minutes for October 30, 2018. Second William Hartman.

Old Business:

There were 2 zoning permits issued in October for a total of \$150.00.

Roadmaster Frank Rishel presented a written report on the road work done in October.

Richard Hess reported on Montour, LLC Pipeline Project that will be coming through our township.

Frank Rishel reported that the Dirt & Gravel Road project on Magargle is complete. The request for final payment along with all the invoices have been submitted.

Richard Hess made a motion to keep the millage for Anthony Township the same for 2019 at a rate of .60 mills. Second William Hartman.

After reviewing the proposed budget Richard Hess made a motion to advertise the budget to be available for public viewing at the township office during business hours. Final adoption to be December 5, 2018 at 7PM. Second Dennis Sheatler.

New Business:

After reviewing a subdivision, Richard Hess made a motion to approve the Minor Subdivision for Dean & Donna Hostetter for property located along Hickory Road. Second Dennis Sheatler.

Robert Buehner, Jr. stated that he will be retiring at the end of 2018 and the township will need to appoint a new Solicitor for 2019. He has been in contact with Laurinda Voelcker and she is willing to fill that position. The board will contact her prior to the reorganization meeting in January. Richard Hess thanked Mr. Buehner for all of the assistance that he has given the township. He will be greatly missed.

Richard Hess discussed the letter that was received from Montour County Commissioners stating that as of 1/1/2019 the recycling program will no longer be available to the residents of Anthony Township. The cost will be more than double for 2019 and it is not in the budget.

Stan Boler: questioned when the minutes are entered on the township website.

Kristine Yarish: asked when the bridge on Foggy Mountain Road will be replaced.
