

## **ANTHONY TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS**

Work Session Meeting

Wednesday December 26, 2018

The meeting was called to order by Richard Hess, Chair, at 6:00 P.M. In attendance were Supervisors Richard Hess, William Hartman, Dennis Sheatler and Roadmaster Frank Rishel.

Discussed attendance at the PSATS State Conference in Hershey on April 14-17, 2019.

Reviewed the invoice from PSATS concerning the dues/magazines, etc. Some of the items that are not useful to the township will be deleted. This will take the total cost from \$1,069.00 to \$747.00.

Penny reported that FEMA information was sent to all residents who filled out paperwork to receive funding. FEMA will not be reimbursing any residents in the township for any flood damage.

Frank & Penny attended a FEMA meeting for reimbursement for flood damage on township roads on Monday December 17<sup>th</sup>. Several documents must be voted on in order for Penny to move forward to file for reimbursement.

- Dennis Sheatler made a motion to adopt Resolution #4 of 2018—Designation of Agent. This resolution appoints Penny Rishel as the Applicant Agent (Point of Contact) and Frank Rishel as the alternate (Form DAP-1). Second Richard Hess.
- Richard Hess made a motion to complete the Public Disaster Assistance application and Agreement for Financial Assistance (Form DAP-2). Second William Hartman.
- Richard Hess made a motion to complete the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; Pennsylvania Electronic Payment Program (PEPP) Enrollment Form. Second Dennis Sheatler.

Discussed a sewage issue on Waltimyer Road. Jim Sanders will move forward with informing the homeowner of the township's concerns.

The meeting schedule for 2019 and reorganization meeting of 2020 was reviewed.

Request for payment for January was reviewed.

No public comment.
