Penny reported on the homeowners that are interested in acquisitioning their homes due to the flood event in August. There are five homes interested in the acquisition option and one home for elevation. The County Commissioners will be submitting a "Letter of Intent" to SEDACOG to begin the process.

Received a request for approval from PennDot concerning a detour plan for a bridge replacement in Derry Township in 2020 on Route 254. The board does not have an issue with the detour. Maps will be made available to the public at the meeting in March.

Received an email request from Exchange Pool to participate in the Raise the Region fund raiser in March. Board tabled the discussion until the March 6 meeting.

Discussed drafting a letter to Senator Gordner and Representative Masser concerning the state police fee that the Governor is proposing. The letter will be ready for approval at the March meeting.
