

## **ANTHONY TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS**

Work Session Meeting

Tuesday June 26, 2018

The meeting was called to order by Richard Hess, Chair, at 6:00 P.M. In attendance were Supervisors Richard Hess, William Hartman, Dennis Sheatler and Roadmaster Frank Rishel. 2 visitors.

Opened and read the bid for Stamm Road Grant Project. There was only one bid from Hammaker East in the amount of \$319,733.20. This amount is \$100,000 more than estimated. A decision will need to be made at the July 3, 2018 monthly meeting as advertised.

Frank Rishel reported that the trees located at the corner of Shetler and Fox Hollow Roads were trimmed today in the morning with no incidents. Penn Line was involved in the trimming of the trees that were causing a hazard to motorist entering Fox Hollow Road from Sheatler Road.

Penny Rishel reported that the township received an invoice from Chip Adams for the service he provided on June 19 at the Nonemaker property. Richard Hess asked Penny to contact Laurinda Voeleker to ask her who the invoice should be sent to since it was done through a court order for the Montour County Zoning office.

There will be a zoning hearing board meeting on Monday July 2, 2018 at the office of Robert Marks at 4:00 PM. Dennis Swartz is requesting a variance on the property located at 4439/4435 Muncy Exchange Road (Betz/Cox). He is asking for the two acre property to be subdivided into two one acre parcels. Due to the fact that both homes are hooked up to one small stream discharge system our SEO, James Sanders, sent a letter stating that it should not be divided into two parcels. After some discussion the board asked Penny to contact our Solicitor Robert Buehner to attend the meeting and if he is not able to then Dennis Sheatler and Penny Rishel will be at the meeting to represent the township.

Discussed the letter from Montour County Commissioners requesting assistance with an additional cost to the recycling program. An additional \$6,000 is needed in order for this program to continue. The board asked Penny to contact Chief Clerk, Holly Brandon, and ask if letters were sent to all the townships and boroughs in the county and what amount they are requesting from each.

Reviewed the appreciation letter to DEP regarding their employee David Hurley, the letter will be read and approved at the July meeting.

Penny Rishel reported that we have been awarded the Dirt & Gravel Road Grant through Montour County Conservation District for Magargle Road. There is a driveway pipe that will need to be replaced at 112 Magargle Road. The family of the property owner will be contacted with this need.

Request for payment for July was reviewed.

No public comment.

There being no further official business. Richard Hess made a motion to adjourn at 7:15 PM. Second Dennis Sheatler.
